# Town of Porter Board of Zoning Appeals Meeting Minutes September 20, 2000

- 2. **Debra Whiten, Public Hearing**: Petitioner is requesting a use variance to run a dog grooming service out of her home (once built) in the Marquette Point subdivision.

The public hearing was opened at 7:05 p.m. There were no individuals present to speak in favor or against the petitioner's request. The public hearing was closed at 7:08 p.m.

Mr. Mandon recommended denial of the petitioner's request, as it did not meet the specifications required to grant a use variance.

Motion by Mr. Bell to deny the request for use variance based upon the findings of fact and the subdivision covenants. Second by Mr. Niepokoj. Motion carried 3-0 with Mr. Childress abstaining based upon conflict of interest (refer to 36-7-4-909 of code.)
