## PORTER METROPOLITAN POLICE COMMISSION Minutes

## January 20, 2009

The Porter Police Commission meeting was called to order at 6 p.m. In attendance were Karen Pisowicz, President; William Donley, Vice-President; Sandi Snyder, Commissioner, Police Chief Jamie Spanier and Town Council Liaison Jon Granat.

As a first order of business, Pisowicz nominated Donley as President with Snyder seconding. Motion carried. Donley then nominated Pisowicz ad Vice-President. Motion carried.

Pisowicz made a motion to accept the December 16, 2008 minutes. Donley seconded. Motion carried.

Under monthly reports, Spanier noted incidents are down, probably due to the cold weather. Donley asked about helping County on drug related cases. Snyder asked for clarification on Operation Pull Over and was given the background that grants are shared by Chesterton, Porter, Burns Harbor and Ogden Dunes on a variety of vehicular infractions, such as no seat belt, drunk driving, following too close, weaving in traffic.

Because of scheduling conflicts, Spanier has scheduled new hire interview for February 3, starting at 4 p.m. Snyder and Pisowicz will attend.

Because of weather, meeting was percheduled for the 14th Under Public Comments, Michelle Bollinger, current Town Council President welcomed the commission members and expressed hope that the two groups would cooperated.

Liaison Granat reported Attorney Patrick Lyp stated an antenna on Highway 20 would cost \$12,000. This will not be done.

Pisowicz asked how the soft ware is going and was told by Spanier that it looks like it might be done by the first of July.
