

PORTER POLICE COMMISSION  
MINUTES

January 15, 2008

The Porter Police Commission was called to order at 6pm.  
In attendance were William Donley, President; Linda Hodges,  
Vice-President; Karen Pisowicz, Commissioner; Chief Jamie  
Spanier and Town Council Liaison Jon Granat.

First order of business was to elect new officers. Linda  
Hodges nominated Karen Pisowicz for president. Bill Donley  
seconded. Motion carried 2-1. Hodges nominated Donley for  
vice-president. Pisowicz seconded. Motion carried.

Donley made a motion to accept the December 18, 2007 minutes  
with the correction of Jen Granat's name. Hodges seconded.  
Motion carried 3-0.

Chief Spanier presented his monthly reports. Hodges noted  
personal mileage was up. She also asked if these statistics  
could be put on a spread sheet to compare each year. This  
would be helpful when asking for additional police personnel.  
Donley asked if the Federal government were the ones that  
handle drug cases. Drug cases are through the County and  
the County will probably double their unit since 80%-90%  
of crimes are directly attributed the drugs.

Pisowicz asked about Pathways Drug Rehab Group and Spanier  
explained it is a nationwide non-profit group that has a  
place in the area but are looking for more space. The program  
is a 1-1/2 program during the day with a pretty high success  
rate. Pathways gets grant money from various places. Pathways  
has given the department brochures to hand out to parents  
having problems with a child and how to seek help.

There was no Old Business.

Under New Business, Spanier reported that several people  
(Officers Todd Allen, Tawny Komisarcik, Commissioner Pisowicz and  
Chief Spanier) met with several candidates for part-time dispatchers.  
The presented list of persons are already trained. The department  
is losing a dispatcher and Hodges asked if the letter from dispatcher  
Larry Lutrick Jr. be read into the record. Hodges read the letter  
(letter attached). It was agreed Spanier would send a letter to Lutrick  
and put it in his file for any future use. Commission agreed by consensus  
to accept the new hires list.

Commission also agreed by consensus to accept Lisa Miller  
as a full time dispatcher.

There were no public comments. Liaison Granat had no  
comments other than to say he understands the department  
is functioning fine.

Donley welcomed Pisowicz as president.
