

PORTER POLICE COMMISSION  
MINUTES

October 16, 2007

The Porter Police Commission meeting was called to order at 6:04 p.m. In attendance were William Donley, President; Linda Hodges, Vice-President; Karen Pisowicz, Commissioner and James Spanier, Chief. Town Liaison Jennifer Granat was absent.

Hodges made a motion to accept the September 18, 2007 minutes. Pisowicz seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

In his monthly reports, Spanier noted citations are down, arrests are up.

There was no Old Business although Hodges mentioned the new timing of lights at Waverly and Highway 20.

Under New Business, Spanier stated 5-6 applicants for reserves with 2 being selected by the committee of Officers Tawny, Torok, McMann and Scott. Spanier would like to use these two as extra help on Halloween. After discussion, Pisowicz made a motion to approve the second man. Hodges seconded. Motion approved 3-0. Hodges made a motion to accept the first candidate. Donley seconded. Motion carried 2-1. Spanier would like to have 7-8 reserves. 80%-90% of the officers started out as reserves.

Under public comments, Jennifer Klug read a letter to the Commission stating she appreciates the crime news being in the newspaper.

Donley stated he had old ammunition in a closet at home and was told to bring it to the station.

Meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
