The Porter Police Commission meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. In attendance were William Donley, President; Linda Hodges, Vice-President; Karen Pisowicz, Commissioner; Chief James Spanier; and Town Council Liaison Jennifer Granat.

Linda Hodges made a motion to approve the April 27, 2007 minutes. Karen Pisowicz seconded. Motion carried. Please note: there was no May 2007 meeting.

Under New Business, the Reserve Policy Update was put off until next meeting. Everyone agreed that the Major Crimes Task Force is a good idea. Also, Spanier requested the Commission forward to the Town Council a recommendation to prohibit on-street parking on Oak Hill Road, East & West. Granat said she would make sure the Council has this on the next agenda.
