The Porter Police Commission was called to order at 6 p.m. In attendance were William Donley, President; Linda Hodges, Vice-President; Karen Pisowicz, Commissioner and Chief James Spanier.

Linda Hodges made a motion to accept the February 20, 2007 minutes. Karen Pisowicz seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

In his monthly report, Spanier noted that things have slowed although they have been quite busy.
