

PORTER POLICE COMMISSION  
MINUTES

November 21, 2006

The Porter Police Commission was called to order. In attendance were Linda Hodges, President; William Donley, Vice-President; Karen Pisowicz, Commissioner; Police Chief James Spanier.

Donley made a motion to approve the October 17, 2006 minutes. Pisowicz seconded. Carried 3-0.

Under monthly reports, Chief Spanier reported things are still quite active with 99 traffic violations.

Under Old Business: Pisowicz reported that the petition regarding highway #20 and Waverly Road was doing great at the gas station; not quite as good at the liquor store. Another place for the petition will be looked into.

Under the abandoned vehicle ordinance, Spanier reported that two changes were legally okay according to the attorney. After discussion, Donley made a motion to accept this ordinance as written and forward it to the Town Council. Pisowicz seconded. Motion carried and Spanier will forward this to the Town Council.


Under New Business: Hiring of part-time officers was discussed with everyone agreeing on applicant "D". After discussion, Donley made a motion to accept applicants "A", "B" and "D". Motion carried with "E" as a stand-by candidate. Spanier will contact the applicants selected and will report to the Commissioners at the next meeting.

Under public comments, Jennifer Klug suggested that the Commission contact the Chesteron Tribune regarding the situation at Route #20 and Waverly Road; put a petition at the Town Hall and bring it up at the next Council meeting.

There were no comments from Commissioners.

Meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
