

PORTER POLICE COMMISSION

MINUTES

July 18, 2006

Original

The Porter Police Commission was called to order at 6:04 p.m. In attendance were Linda Hodges, President; William Donley, Vice-President; Karen Pisowicz, Commissioner and Police Chief James Spanier.

Donley made a motion to approve the minutes. Pisowicz seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

Chief Spanier presented his monthly reports. He also noted that U.S. Steel sponsored two officers, Joe Torok and John McMahon, for a class in interrogation which normally would cost \$1,100 per person. The department also has received 14 candidates for employment. Interviews will be conducted on these candidates.

Under Old Business, the intersection at 20 and Waverly Road will be addressed to see if grants might be available. This will be put on next month's agenda.

There was no New Business or Public Comments.

Pisowicz asked if the new Code Enforcer, Brenda Brueckheimer, is helping the department at the beach. Spanier said it's cheaper than having an officer and she can do other things than just parking ordinances.
