

PORTER POLICE COMMISSION
MINUTES

June 20, 2006

The Porter Police Commission meeting was called to order at 6:10 p.m. by William Donley, vice-president. Also in attendance were Commissioner Karen Pisowicz, Chief James Spanier, Sgt. Todd Allen and Town Council Liaison Jennifer Granat.

Regarding the May 16, 2006 minutes, Spanier noted that the Towing Policy was approved 3-0 at the May 16 meeting. Pisowicz made a motion to accept the minutes as corrected. Donley seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

Chief Spanier gave his monthly reports and noted that things are beginning to pick up at the beach. No parking signs should be up this week. The Police Department will give programs at Yost and Fairhaven schools. NIMS training has been done and Det. Veal had a Search & Seizure seminar.

Under Old Business, the update on traffic problems at US 20 and Wavery Road would be to check on grants available for dangerous intersection.

Under new business, Sgt. Todd Allen reported he and dispatcher Mary Lane interviewed nine persons for part-time dispatcher positions. He presented four names and requested they be accepted by the Commission to bring the pool of dispatchers back to full strength. Karen Pisowicz made a motion to approve the four for radio operators. William Donley seconded. Motion carried 2-0.

Liaison Jennifer Granat stated there would be a budget workshop on Friday at 6p.m.

Commissioner Pisowicz was concerned about the 4th of July parade. Granat mentioned the nuisance ordinance might be used for any problems.

Meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
