The Porter Police Commission was called to order at 6:01 p.m. In attendance were Joe Wagner, President; Karen Pisowicz, Vice-President and Police Chief Jamie Spanier. Absent were Commissioner Mark Lynk and Town Liaison Rob Pomeroy.

Pisowicz made a motion to accept the April 15, 2014 minutes. Motion passed.

During Monthly report, Spanier said things are beginning to pick up. The generator has been installed. Chesterton should be moving dispatch systems to Porter very shortly, possibly over Memorial Day weekend.
