The Porter Police Commission was called to order at 6 p.m. In attendance were Joe Wagner, President; Karen Pisowicz, Vice-President; Mark Lynk, Commissioner; Police Chief Jamie Spanier and Town Liaison Rob Pomeroy.

Pisowicz made a motion to accept the February 18, 2014 minutes. Lynk seconded. Motion carried.

For Monthly Reports, Spanier noted that the department went from 393 calls for service in February to 490 calls in March. Pisowicz asked if the department would be picking up derelict cars. Spanier said they will probably start next month. We try to do one in May and then another in October.

Any trailers have to be behind the front of the house. Pisowicz asked the person complaining about people living in the trailer to come to a Town Council meeting and report on it.

Spanier also asked the Commissioners if they could meet earlier in May, perhaps the 1st Wednesday at 6 p.m. He will make sure the room is open on that date.

The department has 2 reserves right now though they are authorized to have 12.

There was no Old Business or New Business.

Under Commission member comments, Wagner said he went to Plainfield to see training on the track in spite of lousy weather.
