Greg Stinson, President of Porter Town Council, thanked both police and fire personnel and noted how refreshing it is when two departments work together.

Under Commission member comments. Wagner asked for a moment of silence for the passing of K9 Nickey. Wagner also praised the Police Department and Fire Department for working together.
