The Park Safety program went over really well. Wagner said everyone did a really good job and he would like to see this twice a year or at least every year. Stinson noted there were over 160 people at the concert at Hawthorne Park.

Regarding lake patrol at the beach, officer Dan Dickey will be leaving the weekend after the Fourth of July. Police Commission might have to have a special meeting to hire a replacement.

National Lake Shore is having a meeting June 28 asking for input about putting a beach pavillion at Porter Beach and also doubling their parking lot size. Spanier is against any increase in parking in the area. Meeting is 6-8 at the Visitor Center on 49.

Stinson stated with Liaison William Cantrell is resigning from the Council and all committees. Wagner commended Cantrell for his years of service.
