The Brickyard Trail plans are in the process of being revised to include bridges rather than tunnels, and are still on schedule to begin construction next year.

Mr. Genger announced the RDA held their Board of Director's meeting at Town Hall this morning and granted the Town's request to fund year one of the IN 49 Lakeshore Gateway Corridor Development Project in the amount of \$1,816,500.

The Commission by consensus authorized Mr. Genger and Mr. Kieser to keep the project moving forward on all aspects.
