#### Reports

Public Work Director Brenda Brueckheimer requested from the Redevelopment Commission help to fund along with the Stormwater Board the Johnson Street Drainage Project.

Mr. Sexton advised the project is not in the TIF District. Atty Lyp stated the Redevelopment Commission could loan the Stormwater Board the money with the understanding it would have to be paid back.

Engineer Warren Thiede stated the Stormwater Board will be recommending to the Town Council an amendment to the stormwater fee ordinance for commercial property.

Mike Genger made the motion to table the Johnson Street Drainage Project until next meeting; Dave Babcock seconded.

#### **Old Business**

Orchard Pedestrian Bridge -Haas will prepare procurement bids, Lake Michigan Costal gave ok to contract. Bid opening will be April 29<sup>th</sup>, with construction to begin about 8weeks after awardment.

Brick Yard Trail—Representatives from Porter, Chesterton, INDOT, and NIRPC met to discuss the connections of trails between Porter & Chesterton. Porter offered to build two 5 foot wide sidewalks along Jackson Blvd. Chesterton will take under advisement at their next meeting.

TIF Expansion – Dan Botich with Cender & Co. spoke of pruning seven current TIF parcels and adding five new areas, he will write resolution and advertise for public hearing on April 22, 2008 and then again on April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2008.
