Stinson stated after a meeting he had with Nelson, Barry, NIRPC and INDOT it appears our options are somewhat limited as to the changes that can be made to the Trail portion along Woodlawn Avenue without nullifying the current contract with INDOT. The issue is the setback of the houses, with a 12 foot wide trail and no street parking the residents would have to basically parallel park in front of their bay windows. A sidewalk instead of a trail is now currently being discussed, possibly funded by another grant.

Motion to approve payment to INDOT in the amount of \$206,065.53 for the Orchard Pedestrian Way was made by Elka Nelson, with Jeannine Virtue making the second.
